

**We Want The FAIR TAX!**

Dear Public SERVANT:

Regarding taxes, as a public SERVANT, there is really only one question you need to ask yourself: Do you want the citizens to know exactly the cost of government at all levels? (Do you want to know exactly what government is costing you? Your parents? Your children?) If you do, then this reality must be faced – only one taxing mechanism allows the citizen to know exactly what government at all levels is costing. It (a revision of the Founder Fathers’ original indirect uniform tax) was proposed as early as 1929, and has since had one revision so that the working poor are totally untaxed (its called a “prebate”). It is a one-time tax on only new goods and services across the board, bar none, with the exception of education.

A taxing mechanism should be simple, effective, efficient, transparent, inexpensive, and not allow favoritism. There is only one taxing mechanism that is all of those: an across-the-board sales tax. Every time a buyer of goods or services looks at their receipt, that buyer will know exactly what their cost of government is at every level:

Lawnmower:	\$77.00	
Federal Tax:	23.00	(revenue neutral rate for the FAIR TAX as it stands today)
State Tax:	?	
County Tax:	?	
Local Tax:	?	
TOTAL:		\$ ?

It makes no difference what the revenue neutral number is that fills in the “?” because that number is reflecting last year’s cost of government at that level. (What ever the percentage, it is already being paid.)

I am an advocate for the FAIR TAX, AS WRITTEN (HR25 - S1025), the National Retail Sales Tax. However, I am a proponent of this type tax at all levels of government for all of the previously mentioned reasons, as well as many more but too many to mention here (e.g., on average, 22% of the cost of exported goods disappears, making exports dramatically more competitive overnight). Implementation of this sales tax allows all other taxation including “PROPERTY TAXES” to simply be done away with.

The only question left to be asked is “are the public SERVANTS (you included) willing to put a taxing mechanism in place that totally exposes the cost of government at all levels (a scary proposition yes – but truthful and honest) and gives the citizen CHOICE as to if, when, and how much tax they pay, based on their spending habits?” Anything else is a mere Band-Aid approach, which cures NOTHING.

There are 300 million reasons to implement the FAIR TAX, AS WRITTEN (HR25 - S1025), at ALL levels of government, and I am willing to share them with any open mind, at any time, and at no cost.
